- 2. Lay underlayment use a 3 mm rubber roll for shock absorption and sound dampening.
- **3. Install tiles** use the snap-together court flooring lock connection; no adhesive necessary.
- **4. Mark game lines** apply regulation markings with paint or tape.

Maintenance & Care

- Dust mop regularly.
- Clean with neutral-pH cleaner and microfiber mop.
- Store in a climate-controlled area if tiles are removed seasonally.
